# Our Final Newsletter!

Dear Families,

I can't believe this is my last letter to you of this school year. I just wanted to say thank you to you all for your support and kindness in my first full year in my dream job! I have had an absolute ball this year and I am very excited to do it all again in September!

Here are the last few bits of information that you will need between now and the end of term:

#### I) PARENT PAY

This is our new system for paying for school items eg dinners, trips, uniform etc and it goes live on Monday! It is much simpler than the previous system. Mrs Hart has sent you an activation email so you can get started on this. We are also looking at getting a card machine to speed up payments next year too!

#### 2) UNIFORM

School will be open on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> August and Friday I<sup>st</sup> September between 10am – 1pm in order for parents to come and collect pre-ordered uniform if they wish to before school starts. Please take advantage of this as the office will be very busy on the first day back for the children.

Children should wear their school uniform ALL NEXT WEEK. If you have any old, good quality uniform that you'd like to donate to school please hand them in before the end of term or at the start of the next one. We will keep these pre-loved items for anyone in need of them next year.

#### 3) FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals (not infant universal FSM) then you can come and collect your Summer Holiday vouchers from the school office on Monday. Please make sure that this is done when the children AREN'T on the yard. (IO.30am-IIam and I2pm-Ipm) These are allocated by Liverpool City Council and this time they have allocated TESCO vouchers. I am very sorry but we don't have the ability to change them.

### 4) END OF TERM
