








# Curriculum Map- Summer Term

## Early Years Foundation Stage – Nursery (Jonas)

Prime Areas of Learning		
Communication and Language	Physical Development	Personal, Social and Emotional Development
<p><u>Listening, Attention and Understanding</u> We will focus on listening to longer stories and will focus on two step instructions. The children will be learning how to answer why questions.</p> <p><u>Speaking</u> The children will be encouraged to use longer sentences and will be practising pronunciation. They will be encouraged to start conversations with others and continue it for many turns.</p>	<p><u>Fine Motor Skills</u> We have different fine motor activities set up at the beginning of each session alongside our name writing station. Activities such as play dough, threading and jigsaws will be available at all times.</p> <p><u>Gross Motor Skills</u> Outdoor provision develops gross motor skills. Activities such as climbing, lifting, balancing, throwing and catching are all important skills needed for overall physical health, co-ordination and even writing. We will also be playing games each week in PE which will help develop strength and co-ordination.</p>	<p><u>Self-regulation</u> Children will continue to use the strategies they have been taught to self-regulate as and when needed e.g. deep breathing. They will be encouraged to solve small conflicts between themselves.</p> <p><u>Managing Self</u> We will be continuing to encourage the children to develop independent skills and resilience. We want them to try new activities and not give up when they experience difficulties. This includes using the toilet, putting on their own coats, dressing themselves, pouring their own drinks and peeling their own fruit during snack times.</p> <p><u>Building Relationships</u> Children are taught to respect each other and build positive relationships with both their peers and adults. We will support them to resolve conflicts between one another in a respectful way.</p>
Specific Areas of Learning		
Literacy	Mathematics	
 <p>We focus on a different story each week linked to our topics. Our topics this term are 'Sunshine and Sunflowers' and 'Big Wide World'. We also listen to stories and sing rhymes daily. When they are ready, children practise writing their names at the beginning of each session as they arrive at school. We play games focussing on initial sounds of words and practise blending and segmenting. Our phonics table focuses on a different sound each week. We also have mark making opportunities in different areas of our classroom.</p> 	<p>Maths this term will consolidate and expand on topics we have already covered. Activities will be linked to comparison, pattern, shape space and measure, subitising and counting.</p>

Understanding the World		Expressive Arts and Design
 <p><u>Sunshine and Sunflowers</u> This seasonal project provides opportunities for outdoor learning and teaches children how to care for the plants and animals in their local environment and how to stay safe in the sun.</p>	 <p><u>Big Wide World</u> This project teaches children about the global community to which they belong and explores how living things, communities and climates differ around the world.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explore creating with different materials.</li> <li>• Observational drawings and paintings.</li> <li>• Constructing using different materials.</li> <li>• Singing songs.</li> <li>• Play with instruments with increasing control.</li> <li>• Drawing with increasing complexity e.g. drawing a face with details.</li> <li>• Develop stories combining small world equipment and construction kits.</li> </ul>

Phonics	We are learning early phonetic skills in nursery. We play with sounds through songs, rhymes, stories and games. We are continuing to focus on initial sounds and oral blending and have a 'sound of the week' table.
